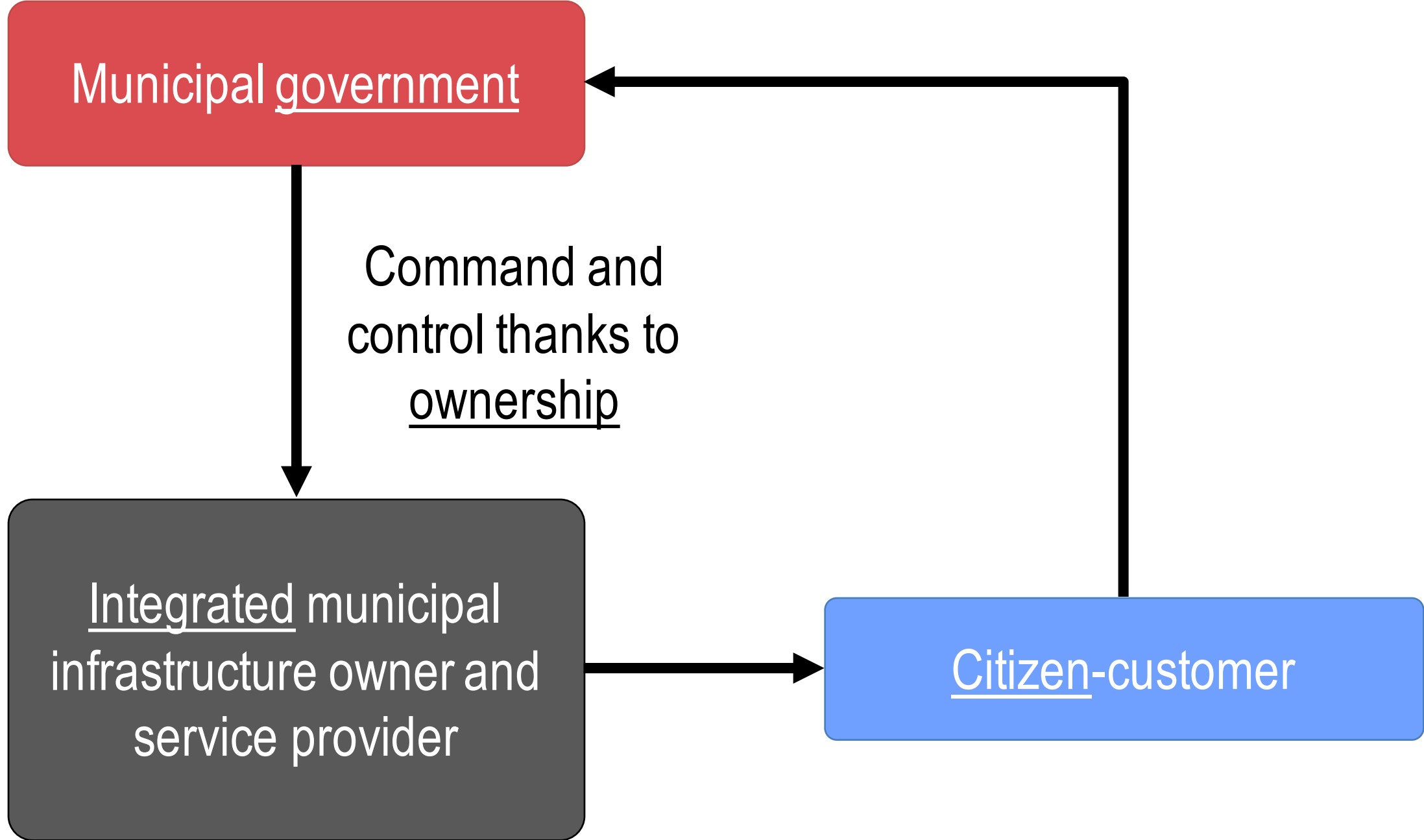

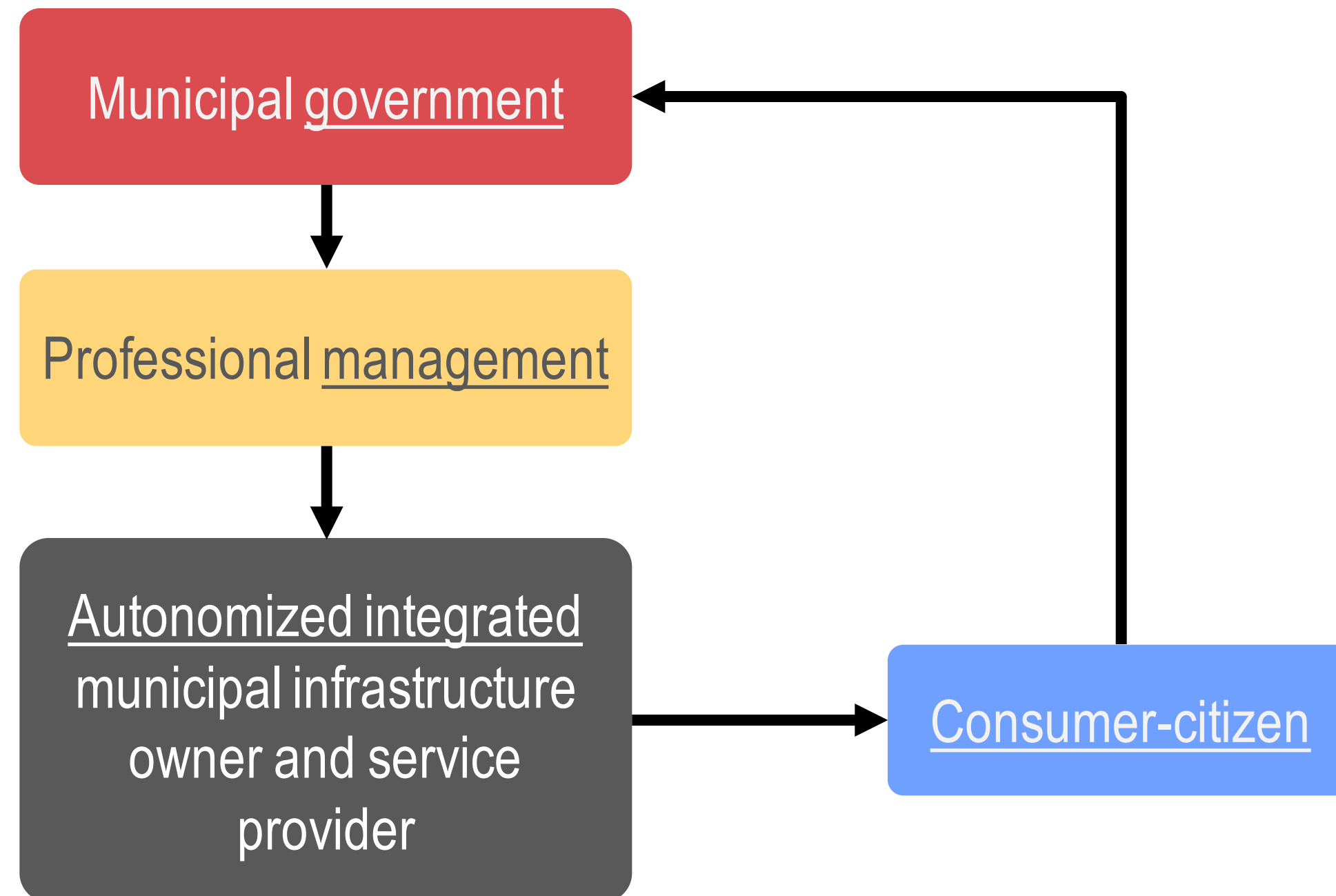

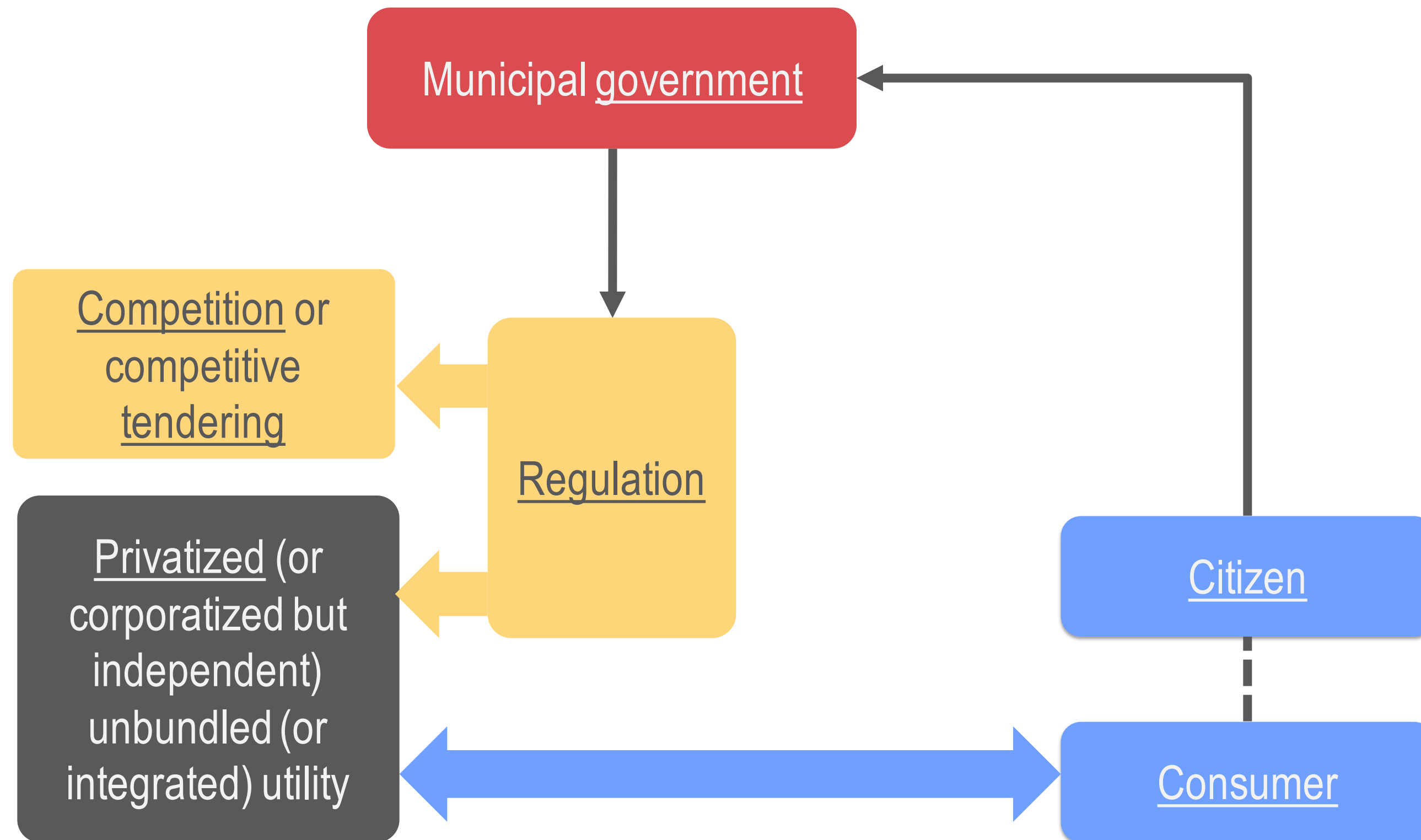
- Public management

New public management





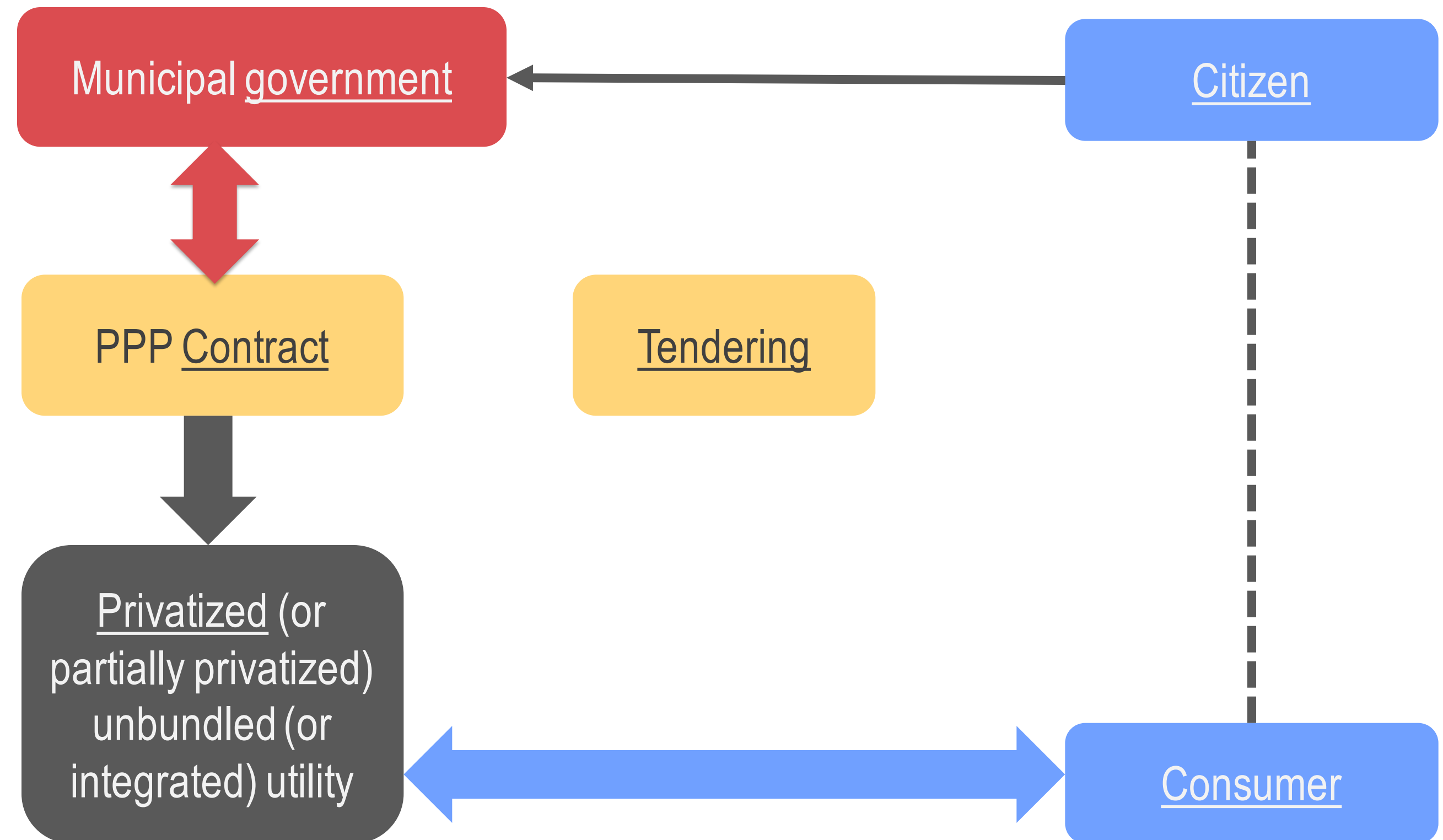
PPP (Public-Private-Partnership)

Management PPPs:

- Management contract
- Lease contract
- Concession

Financial PPPs:

- Build-Operate-Transfer (BOT)
- Build-Transfer-Operate (BTO)
