

## CONTRIBUTION GUIDELINE

-IGLUSblog-

IGLUS publishes research through IGLUS Quarterly and IGLUS-blog. The text submitted for IGLUSblog should be between **1,500** and **2,000** words, that is, **15,000** to **20,000** characters without spaces. However, if you have longer, in-depth research that you would like to publish in a different format, you may consider submitting it for IGLUS Quarterly (please see: <a href="http://iglus.org/quarterly/">http://iglus.org/quarterly/</a>). Your text can be in the following formats: \*.doc, \*.docx and \*.pdf.

Authors are encouraged to submit essays about their experiences and opinions on recent developments in urban context for the IG-LUSblog. For references (in the form of text or visuals), please use intext citation or footnotes, depending on the type of your text. If it is a research article, you should use **Harvard** or **APA** citation styles.

The visuals (photos, diagrams, maps, etc.) you embed in your article should be sent separately in the following formats: \*.jpg, \*.jpeg, \*.png, \*.tiff. If the visuals are too large to be sent as an e-mail attachment (over 20 MB), please use Google Drive or other file transfer methods. Please add the captions of your visuals into the text you submit. It is important that you use either your own visuals or the ones that you have the permission for use. For the latter, you should add a caption that includes copyright information. The visuals that are found online should be cited with the link of the website that contains the visual.

Audios and videos that you would like to include in your article should also be your own or royalty-free. Please also make sure that they are suitable for embedding. If videos or audios are recorded by you, please upload them to one of the platforms such as **Google Drive** or **YouTube**.

We publish original content. If you have submitted your article to any other publication simultaneously, please inform us. We will not be able to publish articles that have already been published elsewhere. However, if your article was published in a language other than English or French, we can publish it in one of these languages, referring to your previous publication and indicating that it is a translation.

As a standard, we respond to your inquiries in one week. However, please note that sometimes this can be a little longer. After you submit your piece or inquiry, you will be contacted by our editors. We publish articles on a schedule; so, after the review, your article will be published according to our time plan. You will be informed about the publishing date.
